As if a wonderful meal wasn't enough, the tireless Kenyans entertained us, singing and dancing around the room and inviting us to join in.

The whole Kenyan community stayed to clean up with some learning how to operate our dishwasher and others, especially Alice, non-stop at the sink. They were really terrific hard workers and pleasant to be with at the same time. We really can't thank our Kenyan friends enough for a very special and memorable experience. Margaret, for orchestrating the whole affair and working tirelessly. Caroline and Godfrey for days of prep and a full day on Saturday as well.



Bible Study




